CATEGORY AWARDS

The judging process begins by jurying the photos. Those photos that make it through the jurying process are then judged and scored on each of the following areas: Technical Quality, Composition, Impact, Originality, and Artistic Appeal. Each juried photo is given 1-10 points in each of the 4 areas with a possible top score of 40 points from each judge resulting in a possible top score of 120 points. The judge's decisions are final.

Scores are recorded on a spreadsheet, totaled and sorted to reflect the best scores within each category. Any resulting ties are re-scored by the judges. Since the winning photos are determined ahead of time by scores, we are able to print them in our show program for your enjoyment.

SPECIALTY AWARDS

These are awards sponsored by individuals and groups that have a 'special' interest in the subject; which they have chosen to issue an award. Some sponsors pick their winner, but others choose to have a judge pick the winner. Prizes in this area include ribbons, cash awards, and gift certificates.




